

The Story of the Očić Salon

Priča o salonu Očić

A respectable family from Zagreb refurbished an old outbuilding, or a barn, situated on their land (which they have owned since the 14th century) not only to live there, but to play music there too.

For the past 25 years, the space has been resounding with carefully chosen music played by excellent and respectable musicians at concerts broadcast live by Croatian Radio 3.

The founder and president of the Franjo Dugan Society, who started organising the concerts as get-togethers for its members and the organist Ljerka Očić is also the hostess of the concerts, which are held in her living space.

This documentary radioscope, recorded at one of the pre-Christmas musical events in the salon, provides details from the history of the Očić family, the atmosphere before and after the concert, as well as details about past concerts.
